



TOR buses can take you to Summer Sessions at Fieldstone Secondary School

TOR bus route #94 serves Fieldstone School once each hour, both northbound and southbound. To see the TOR #94 bus schedule and map, go to www.rocklandgov.com and click on the bus. **The Fieldstone School bus stop on the TOR #94 schedule is called "Letchworth Village."** On our web site you can also find bus routes from your neighborhood that will let you transfer to TOR #94. Cash fare for TOR buses is \$1.50 per ride, plus 30¢ for a transfer. SuperSaver discount tickets provide the same ride for only 90¢ (10 rides for \$9.00, including transfers.)

TOR Bus trips from other school districts to Fieldstone School:

- **From Orangetown and Ramapo** take TOR #94 northbound from the Spring Valley Transit Center (Spring Valley train station) once each hour at 6:30 AM, 7:30, 8:30, etc. The bus sign will say "94 TOMKINS COVE" or "94 HELEN HAYES HOSPITAL." You can transfer to TOR #94 by taking TOR #59, 92, 93 or Loop 3. Possible transfer locations include Spring Valley, Rockland Community College, Yeager Center and Mt. Ivy. TOR buses can also be flagged down between stops.
- **From Clarkstown and Haverstraw** transfer to TOR #94 southbound by taking TOR #91 to the bus shelter at Helen Hayes Hospital. TOR #94 southbound departs from Helen Hayes Hospital once each hour at 6:37 AM, 7:37, 8:37, etc. The bus sign will say "94 SPRING VALLEY."
- **From Stony Point** take TOR #94 southbound from Tomkins Cove, Stony Point Park & Ride lot and Helen Hayes Hospital. TOR buses can also be flagged down between those stops. The bus sign will say "94 SPRING VALLEY."
- **To go home from Fieldstone School** flag down TOR # 94 at the end of the school's driveway. Check the bus schedule for departure times from the "Letchworth Village" bus stop.



In addition to going to school, TOR buses provide a great way to go to work, to the mall or just to go to parks and swimming pools all over Rockland County. Save your gas money for more important things and take the green and white TOR bus instead. Check out TOR schedules online or call us for trip planning. We'll take you there!
